

Rules of Play Update - November 2021

We'd like to go through the Rules of Play that will be posted to the website and around the club.

Members came to us with suggestions and we listened.

First off - a reminder that we are still requiring members to check in for contact tracing and proof of vaccination.

Whether you check in with Rick or someone at the bar, or the skip does it on behalf of the team, check in. Don't assume Rick saw you, he might not have. Our staff is busy. We have to stick to our process in order to comply with the Health Unit.

1. If you have any cold, flu, fever symptoms – please stay home. Simple.
2. We have sanitizer around the club, use it.
3. Masks must be worn in the Curling Club, including locker rooms as per Health Unit recommendations. Basically, masks everywhere but at the table to eat and drink and on the ice to curl.
4. Locker Rooms - AS OF DECEMBER 1ST - Locker rooms will be OPEN.
 - a. Traffic Flow - we will continue to go upstairs. We will continue to use designated tables according to the Sheet you are playing on.
 - b. If you DO NOT choose to use the locker rooms, place your coat on the chair and put your curling shoes on

- c. If you DO choose to use the locker rooms, proceed to the ice lobby down the back stairway. Masks must be worn and please respect each other's space while in the locker rooms.
 - d. USE of Locker rooms is your choice. We want our members to be comfortable.
5. Rules of Play - Not much change here. We look to be back to a new normal curling, with either one or two sweepers. Tap brooms instead of shaking hands. 3rds determine hammer. 3rds put up the score. Pick someone to sanitize the rocks, maybe give the 3rds a break ;) Don't place opposition rocks out. Skips are back sweeping behind the T. Just a reminder to respect each other's space. Distance If you aren't sweeping or throwing, walk along the left side facing the clock or on an empty sheet.
6. Kitchen and Bar - Kitchen and Bar will be open following Ontario Restaurant and Food Services and safety during COVID-19 and physical distancing guidelines, please observe traffic flow and wait line indicators for the Kitchen and Bar. Don't forget to return plates and cutlery to the basket on the car. Return your bottles etc to the bar. Every little bit helps.

Lockers - if you don't remember your number and combination, talk to Rick. December 1st is the date.
