

**FORT FRANCES CURLING CLUB MEMBERSHIP RATES
2022-2023 Curling Season**

**All Rates apply to Evening or Day Leagues
HST and NOCA Dues included**

Standard Membership – applies to one league. Spare fees must be paid if sparing in another league. Practice ice when available is \$10.00 per session.

Premium Membership – unlimited curling in multiple leagues, practice ice (subject to availability), sparing and clinics.

Full Season:

Standard Membership – 1 League	\$400.00
Premium Membership – unlimited curling	\$600.00
5 th and/or 6 th Player on a team (each)- Standard membership applies	\$150.00

Half Season: Oct to Dec or Jan- Apr

Standard Membership - 1 League	\$210.00
Premium Membership - unlimited curling	\$310.00
5 th or 6 th player on each team - Standard membership applies	\$ 85.00

(If one member is playing the first half of the season and another the second half of the season they each pay the half season rate.)

Student (Under 24 full time and not part of the Junior/Bantam Program – proof of enrollment required)
(Applies to students with deferral for College and University due to COVID-19)

Standard Membership (half season Oct-Dec \$160)	\$300.00
Premium Membership (half season Oct-Dec \$230)	\$450.00

Little Rockers 8-11 years \$175.00 includes practice and league. Parents are responsible for an additional \$50.00 fundraising fee.

Bantam/Junior 12-19 years \$225.00 includes practice and league. Parents are responsible for an additional \$50.00 fundraising fee.

Spare Fee \$10.00 per game – no cap
(Spare fees to be paid prior to accessing the ice, along with the completion of the FFCC Club participation waiver form)

New Member (Since 2016)

Standard Membership	\$320.00
Premium Membership	\$500.00

FULL TEAM ENTRIES PREFERRED.

Easy Payment Plan: Total fees plus \$10.00 handling fee – payable in 4 equal payments.
Due: September 21, October 17, November 21 and December 12, 2022

All fees not on the payment plan must be paid in full by October 31, 2022 – a \$25.00 penalty will be applied to outstanding memberships.

REFUND PROCEDURE

1. The refund will apply to all members, regardless of age group or curling league.
2. In the event of an injury or illness that results in the member's inability to continue to curl, the refund will be on a prorata basis. Documentation may be required. After January 1st, requests will be considered but as a credit toward the next season.
3. In the event that the member has moved and is unable to curl, the refund will be on a prorata basis. Refund requests will only be considered up to December 31st.
4. NOCA dues will be considered fully earned and non refundable
5. Refunds will be considered for requests other than illness or injury (b) move, (c) only up to 30 days from the start of the season.
6. Refund request must be a written request to the Board. An email will be considered a written request.
7. A \$10.00 administration fee will apply.
